

EGR 215 Project Grading Rubric

Selection of the project topic (10%)	Covers the dynamics of the motion of a rigid object. Requires an analysis that goes beyond the typical solution of a textbook problem.
Analysis (60%)	Done correctly and completely. Shows initiative, e.g. by researching the current literature, carrying out an experiment, using computer methods, etc.
Report (may be given as a set of presentation slides) (15%)	<p>Well organized and clearly written and articulated. The text is easy to follow. Diagrams enhance the presentation of ideas.</p> <p>Includes a peer evaluation of the team members</p>
Presentation (15%, but not presenting automatically takes 50% off the project score)	<p>Visual aids: Material is readable and the graphics highlight and support the main ideas.</p> <p>Oral presentation: Speakers are audible and fluent on their topic</p> <p>All team members contribute equally to the presentation.</p>
Team work (based on a peer evaluation included in the report)	Each member contributes in a valuable way to the project. All members always attended meetings and met deadlines for deliverables. Provided that all members contributed equally, all members will receive the same score for their project. If one member contributed less, the member will receive a lower score than the other team members.
